

ORANGE: GATES OF HELL

Alternate Stitch (C)

With orange, loosely chain 23

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across (22 sc)

Row 2: (right side) ch1, turn; skip first sc (sc,dc) in next sc, *skip next sc, (sc,dc) in next sc; repeat from * across.

Row 3: ch1, turn; (sc,dc) in each dc across.

Repeat Row 3 until desired length is achieved.

Fasten off and weave in ends.



Vertical Weave (K)

This pattern allows for 2 rows as a border at the beginning and end as well as 2 knit stitches on the left and right. The last stitch is knitted through back loop (tbl). This twists the stitch and helps to keep the edges from curling.

CO 22

Beginning Border:

Row 1: Knit Across

Row 2: K2, Purl 18, K1, K1tbl (through back loop)

Begin stitch pattern.

Stitch Pattern:

Row 1: (Right Side) K2 for border, K2 *sl 1 as if to Purl, K1, YO, PSSO both the knit st and YO, K2. Repeat from * across to last 2 stitches. K1, K1tbl.

Row 2: K2, Purl 18, K1, K1tbl.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for pattern until desired length.

Ending Border:

Row 1: Knit Across

Row 2: K2, Purl 18, K1, K1tbl (through back loop)

Bind off and weave in ends.
